

Thunder Bay Christian Homeschoolers Liability Waiver

This Waiver is signed on this ___ day of _____, 2025, by the undersigned (“Participant”) for Thunder Bay Christian Homeschoolers (“TBCH”), a group of families organizing activities, sharing knowledge, and making connections. TBCH is not a registered organization.

Non-Registered Organization

TBCH is not a formal organization but a collaborative effort among families. It operates without formal status and is sustained through the voluntary efforts of its participants.

Registration Fees

Any registration fees collected by TBCH are solely to subsidize the cost of activities and events, not for profit.

Assumption of Risk

Participation in TBCH activities involves risks such as injury, illness, property damage, and the unlikely possibility of death. TBCH does not provide group insurance. Each family is responsible for their own insurance and assumes all risks. If TBCH provides insurance for any specific event, it will be clearly stated in advance.

Parental Supervision Required

A parent or guardian must stay with their children at all TBCH activities and actively supervise them. No activities are drop-off. Parents or guardians are fully responsible for their children’s safety and behaviour.

Code of Conduct

All members are expected to behave in a respectful manner that reflects Christian values, including refraining from bullying, harassment, or disruptive behaviour. TBCH is not a platform for political views of any kind. All TBCH activities should be taught from a Christian viewpoint only, with no political viewpoints or other religious beliefs included. Violations of this code of conduct may result in removal from the group.

Statement of Faith

Participants must review the TBCH Statement of Faith at tbch.ca before registering. By registering, participants agree to respect this Statement of Faith and not discuss anything contrary to it at TBCH activities.

Release and Waiver

By participating in TBCH activities, the Participant releases, waives, and agrees not to sue TBCH, its organizers, volunteers, or other participants for any claims related to loss, damage, injury, including death. This applies to the Participant and anyone who might sue on their behalf. The Participant agrees to protect TBCH, its organizers, and volunteers from any claims or lawsuits arising out of participation in TBCH activities.

Medical Treatment

The Participant consents to necessary medical treatment if injured during TBCH activities and agrees to be responsible for all medical costs.

Governing Law

This Waiver is governed by Ontario law. If any part of this Waiver is found invalid, the rest will still be in effect.

Acknowledgment of Understanding

The Participant acknowledges reading and understanding this Waiver and agrees to its terms, giving up certain rights, including the right to sue. The Participant signs this Waiver freely and voluntarily.
